Lake Antoine Park is located in Dickinson County in the City of Iron Mountain and Breitung Township and is maintained and operated by the Parks Department of Dickinson County. Lake Antoine Park has something for people of all ages, from camping to volleyball, swimming to boating, picnicking and barbequing and everything in between.



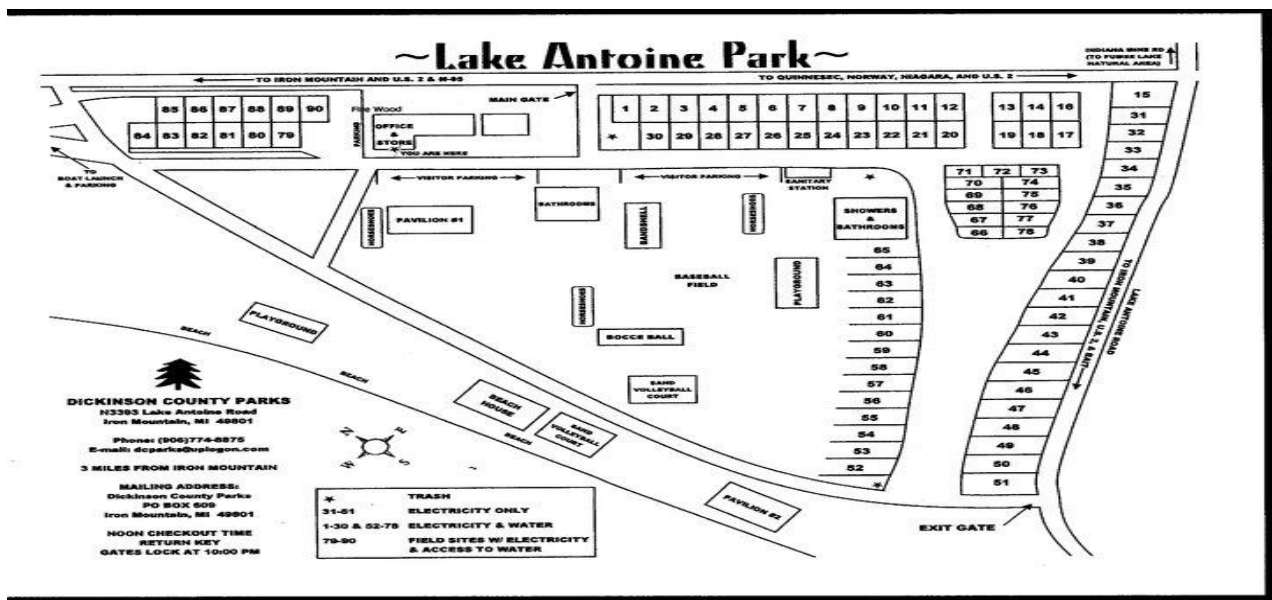
Lake Antoine Park is open to the public from Memorial Day Weekend through Labor Day Weekend, from 8 am to 10 pm with **free admittance**. The lake features two boat landings, one operated and maintained by the County, and the other by the City of Iron Mountain. The Park features two pavilions and a bandshell available for rent throughout the summer.

Camping

Lake Antoine Park is open for camping from Memorial Day Weekend to Labor Day Weekend offering various amenities. A Camp Host will be on site during the camping season. Reservations can be made by calling the County Park Office at (906)-774-8875.

Fees

- \$5.00 Reservation Fee
- \$20.00 per night camping fee for Dickinson County Residents
- \$24.00 per night camping fee for Out-of-County campers
- Discounts offered for longer camping stays, long term lease programs available



Pavilions

There are two 64'X30' pavilions available for rent at the park providing the perfect accommodations for large groups. Pavilions include electricity and 12 picnic tables that seat 72 people. Additional tables are available outside of the pavilions. The cost is \$75.00 per day, \$25.00 of which is a refundable clean up deposit, payable upon inspection and approval by the Park Manager.

Bandshell

The bandshell is available to rent for your special occasion. The bandshell includes electricity, and is adjacent to restroom facilities. The cost is \$125.00 per day, which includes a \$50.00 deposit, refundable upon inspection and approval by the Park Manager.
